

Mark's Z-scale Locomotives ("Loks")



8800 – Tank Locomotive
A model of the 0-6-0 class 89 locomotive. Three driven axles.



8801 – Tank Locomotive
Belgium State Railways' (NMBS/SNCB) class 96.
Coupling hook in front.



8802 – Track Cleaning Locomotive
Two of the three axles on the track cleaning car are powered. The wheels on the rear and front axles are grooved. The cleaning wheels on the front axle turn faster than the wheels on the inner and rear axles, thus causing dirt to be thrown off of the track.



8804 – Diesel Locomotive (qty 3)
German Federal Railroad class 260. All axles powered.



8807 – "Mikado" Locomotive with Tender
Southern Railway USRA 2-8-2.
All driving axles powered. Single headlight at the front.



8811 – Passenger Locomotive (qty 2)
German Federal Railroad class 144. Both trucks powered.
(aka "Green Croc Lok")

Triple headlight both ends, changes with the direction of travel.



8822 – Freight Locomotive (qty 3)
German federal Railroad class 194. Both trucks powered.
(aka "Green Croc Lok")

Three headlights at each end, changing over with change of direction.

German Federal Railways class 216 4-4 locomotive.
3 headlights at each end, changing over with change of direction

Produced only in 1982 for the 10th anniversary of Märklin mini-club

German Federal Railroad class 218. All axles powered.
Maintenance-free LED's for headlights.



8885 – Express Train Locomotive with Tender

German Federal Railroad class 003. All driving axles powered.

Until 1978 the world record for continuous running for model railroads in the famous "Guinness Book of Records" was 440.7 km (275.44 miles) in about 300 hours. The 8885 mini-club locomotive with 6 passenger cars ran 720 km (450 miles) without stopping in 1,219 hours. The new record was set in an independent test facility.

A model of the former German State Railway's BR 18/4. Wheel arrangement 4-6-2.
